- Positive results should include either a focus on community impact or cultural enrichment through music, dance and the arts.
- Actions of the nominee(s) must have occurred within the past 12 months, approximately July 2009 through June 2010.
- Self-nominations and nominations of KSER Board and staff members and KSER on-air hosts will not be accepted.
